SCHEDULING ORDER, HEARING DATE, AND APPROVED FORM OF NOTICE FOR A MOTION TO SET FINAL CLAIM DATE

Upon Supplemental Motion of Stephen W. Kimbell, Commissioner of
Department of Financial Regulation as Receiver for and Liquidator ("Liquidator")
of Ambassador Insurance Company ("Ambassador"), for a scheduling order,
hearing date and approved form of notice for a motion to set a Final Claim Date,
and considering the memorandum of law in support thereof, this Court hereby
orders:

- The Liquidator shall file a motion to establish a Final Claim Date within thirty
 (30) days of the date of this Order.
- Hearing on such motion is set for 9 o'clock a.m. on October 16, 2012, at the
 Vermont Superior Court, 65 State Street, Montpelier, Vermont.
- Opposition to and support for such motion, signed by the claimant and setting forth all objections or comments with supporting documentation, shall be filed in Vermont Superior Court, referencing the docket number for this matter, no later than September 5, 2012, and served upon counsel for the Liquidator as specified in the mailed and published Notice. Replies to such filings may be filed no later than October 2, 2012, and served only upon those filing an opposition or supportive comment.

- 4. The Court finds that Notice of the Motion, Date for filing Opposition or Supportive comments and Hearing date should be provided to individuals and entities as described below, and hereby finds sufficient Notice substantially in the form attached hereto to be served at the time the Motion is filed, as follows:
 - a. By first class mail to the insurance commissioner of each jurisdiction in which Ambassador did business, as well as to any guaranty association which has or may still become obligated as a result of Ambassador's liquidation;
 - b. By first class mail to the last known address, as indicated by the records of the Liquidator, of all policyholders, as well as others known to have claims against Ambassador at the time of the liquidation, except for policyholders and claimants under personal automobile or homeowner policies;
 - c. Published twice within two weeks from the Motion's filing date in the certain newspapers in Vermont and New Jersey as selected by the Liquidator, and additionally in the national editions of the *Wall Street Journal, New York Times* and *Business Insurance*; and
 - d. Posted on the Internet website maintained by Ambassador Insurance Company in Liquidation (http://www.ambassadorliquidation.com) that can be reached by link from the Vermont Department of Financial Regulation website.

The approved form of Notice is attached hereto and shall be completed by the Liquidator with appropriate dates and addresses prior to service as consistent with this Order.
